“USE PIN CODE ON YOUR POSTAL ARTICLES TO REACH ADDRESSEE VERY PROMPTLY”

A correct address with PIN code helps to reach the Postal articles (Envelop, Post Card, RL, Speed Post, Ins. MO. Etc.) easily and quickly to addressee.

The full name of PIN is “Postal Index Number”. Postal Department had introduced Postal Index Number (PIN) code on 15th August, 1972.

ADVANTAGE OF PIN CODE USE :

For advantage of receipt & dispatch of Indian Postal Mail, the Indian Postal Department divided to all India in 9 PIN regions. Every region is divided some PIN Sub-regions, every sub-region is divided some Districts and every District is divided some Post offices.

PIN comprises of 6 digits. The first digit of the PIN code indicates the PIN region. The second digit indicates the sub-region and the third digit indicates District within sub-region. The final three digits are assigned to individual delivery Post offices, ie the Post offices through which mail is to be delivered.

For example, any person from Channai sent a mail (letter / Parcel / Mo etc.) to any person under Bheduasole Post office in Bankura District (WB) whose PIN code is 722121. The first digit '7' is indicates North-East PIN region, the second digit '2' is indicates WB PIN sub-region, the third digit '2' indicates Bankura District (WB) and final three digits '121' indicate Bheduasole Post office. Accordingly the Postal article reached far away from Channai to Bheduasole Post office easily and quickly by the help of PIN code. The Postmaster / Delivery staff of Bheduasole Post office can deliver the article to addressee easily and quickly.

Therefore, all are requested to use PIN code in address.

“USE OF PIN CODE MEANS QUICK TRANSMISSION OF POSTAL ARTICLES”

PIN code is given of all Delivery Post offices under Bankura Postal Division.
